## MAJOR/MINOR/ELECTIVES


$\bullet 18$ hours $\geq$ C (not C-) required in major core: includes ENGL 120 and above. No more than 45 hours of English (excluding ENGL 100 and 105) may count toward graduation. If minoring with Creative Writing, may overlap two courses above 200.
(\#) Should ideally be taken as early in the student's major path as possible.
(\#\#) Students must choose four elective courses between ENGL 200 and 699. Students have the option to group these electives within a concentrated area of study called a "pathway." Pathways are not required, but choosing (or creating) one can help focus studies (e.g., in order to prepare for graduate school or to develop an area of interest to pursue later as a profession). Students may create their own pathway or choose one of several pre-selected pathways. See the online catalog (catalog.unc.edu) for list of preselected pathways.
*Courses marked with an asterisk may fit more than one category. However, such a course may only be counted once; e.g., ENGL 347 may count as fulfilling either the 1660-1900 or the post-1900 requirement, but not both.
